SUPPORT STAFF

The support staff is made up of parent volunteers. Parent support is the difference between a basic program and one that allows students to have the best band experience possible. New parent volunteers are needed and welcome. There will be a wide variety of tasks where volunteers are needed. Here is a listing of the various committees. Please take the time to find an area of interest and lend your support.

SEWING / AUXILIARY

This group is primarily responsible for sewing flags and costumes for the field shows. This process includes cutting material pieces, pinning pattern pieces, sewing the actual flags and costumes, and repairs. We always need help in this area. Both experienced and non-sewers alike are welcome.

UNIFORMS

This group has a wide variety of duties. It starts with fitting each band member into a uniform and making any necessary alterations. They manage the check out of the uniforms. They maintain a record of all uniform pieces checked out to the students. This is an ongoing committee that can always use volunteers.

PIT CREW

This crew has varied responsibilities. Transporting equipment to and from practices and field shows. Volunteers are needed throughout the season at various times.

FOOD

This committee is responsible for keeping the band members feed at the field shows. No food handler's license is required.

CHAPERONES

Parental help and support is needed at various activities. A chaperone training meeting will be arranged for after the first parent meeting and is mandatory for any parent interested in being a chaperone on any band trip.

COFFEE CART

The band parents own a portable coffee cart, which is used to earn money for the general fund. We are always looking for parent volunteers for this area. We try to have the cart at as many of the sporting events that we can get staffing for.

The band and color guard host a web site in order to improve our communication with parents and students. The web site hosts information that is vital to both students and parents. This includes schedules, pictures, and any required forms that students and parents may need to download.
